North European Championship Sporting Regulations 2017

1. Championship

This is the Sporting Regulations for:

Formula STCC Nordic NEZ North European Championship 2017 (Short: F STCC Nordic NEZ Championship 2017).

These Sporting Regulations come into force from the moment they are published on the NEZ web-cite www.fia-nez.eu, where possible changes, bulletins etc, will be published.

2. Title and Jurisdiction

The **F STCC Nordic NEZ Championship 2017** is handled by the NEZ Racing Commission in association with respectively ASN's Racing Commissions or their representatives within the NEZ and STCC. The entrants are enforced to follow the General Sporting Regulations from hosting ASN and the Promoter STCC.

Competitors must ensure that their cars comply with the conditions of eligibility and safety throughout qualifying and racing.

3. Eligible Drivers

The events will be national and are open to drivers with an appropriate, valid driver's license, including startingpermission from their respectively ASN.

Only drivers with a license issued by an ASN within the NEZ-countries can score points in the Championship.

4. Eligible Cars

Cars must fulfill requirements of the Formula STCC Nordic Reglemente, Tävlingsreglemente och Tekniskt reglemente 2017, Official Formula STCC Nordic Technical Regulations 2017 and Formula STCC Nordic User Manual 2014 v1.1 & Nomenclature 2014 UK.

Tire restriction according to §10.

Noice level according to Formula STCC Nordic Reglemente, Tävlingsreglemente och Tekniskt reglemente 2017, Official Formula STCC Nordic Technical Regulations 2017 and Formula STCC Nordic User Manual 2014 v1.1 & Nomenclature 2014 UK.

5. Championship Rounds 2017

19 – 20 th , May 2017, Alastaro, FINLAND	(two heats)
03 – 04 th , June 2017, Rudskogen, NORWAY	(two heats)
01 – 03 rd , Sept 2017, Anderstorp, SWEDEN	(two heats)

6. Points

Each heat will count towards the Championship, point will be awarded based as below:

Plac.	1 st	2 nd	3 rd	4 th	5 th	6 th	7 th	8 th	9 th	10 th
Points	25	18	15	12	10	8	6	4	2	1

The winner of the **F STCC Nordic NEZ Championship 2017** is the driver awarded most points after the last heat. In the case of two or more drivers having the same number of points after the last heat, the result of the last heat decides the ranking for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place overall.

7. Entries

Competitors are responsible for sending in correct and complete entry to STCC AB.

8. Free Practice, Qualifying and Race

According to each event/organizer's time schedule.

Friday or Saturday: Timed qualifying.

Saturday or Sunday: Heat 1 and heat 2.

- Grid for heat 1 will be determined by the timed qualification.
 - The driver, who has reached the second fastest qualifying laptime, will start at the pole position.
- Grid for heat 2 will be determined by the timed qualifying.
 - The driver, who has reached the fastest qualifying laptime, will start at the pole position.

9. Fuel

According to Formula STCC Nordic Reglemente, Tävlingsreglemente och Tekniskt reglemente 2017, Official Formula STCC Nordic Technical Regulations 2017 and Formula STCC Nordic User Manual 2014 v1.1 & Nomenclature 2014 UK.

10. Tire and tire limitation

All competitors must have their own or rented time-keeping transponder mounted and working when the car is on the track (free practice, qualifying and race).
