North European Cup Sporting Regulations 2019

1. Championship

This is the Sporting Regulations for:

Formula Nordic NEZ North European Cup 2019 (Short: F Nordic NEZ Cup 2019).

These Sporting Regulations come into force from the moment they are published on the NEZ web-site www.fia-nez.eu, where possible changes, bulletins etc, will be published.

2. Title and Jurisdiction

The **F Nordic NEZ Cup 2019** is handled by the NEZ Racing Commission in association with respectively ASN's Racing Commissions or their representatives within the NEZ. The entrants are enforced to follow the General Sporting Regulations from hosting ASN. Competitors must ensure that their cars comply with the conditions of eligibility and safety throughout qualifying and racing.

3. Eligible Drivers

The events will be national and are open to drivers with an appropriate, valid driver's license, including starting permission from their respectively ASN.

Only drivers with a license issued by an ASN within the NEZ-countries can score points in the Trophy.

4. Eligible Cars

FORMULA Renault 1.6 manufactured by Signatech Automobiles, fulfilling the requirements of the Formula Nordic Reglemente 2019, Official Formula Nordic Technical Regulations 2019, Formula Nordic User Manual 2014 v1.1 & Nomenclature 2014 UK, Official Formula Nordic Car 2019 – sticker placement and Official Formula Nordic Suit 2019 – badge placement.

Tire restriction according to §10.

Noise level according to Formula Nordic Reglemente 2019, Official Formula Nordic Technical Regulations 2019 and Formula Nordic User Manual 2014 v1.1 & Nomenclature 2014 UK.

5. Championship Rounds 2019

01 – 02 nd , Jun 2019, Anderstorp, SWEDEN	(two heats)
14 – 15 th , Jun 2019, Skellefteå, SWEDEN	(three heats)
17 – 18 th , Aug 2019, Karlskoga, SWEDEN	(three heats)
13 – 14 th , Sep 2019, Rudskogen, NORWAY	(three heats)
28 th , Sep 2019, Karlskoga, SWEDEN	(three heats)
04 – 05 th , Oct 2019, Mantorp Park, SWEDEN	(two heats)

6. Points

Each heat will count towards the Trophy, points will be awarded based as below and in addition, bonus points with reference to § 8 (as below) in the Officiellt Formula Nordic Reglemente 2019.

§ 8 Bonus points

Timed qualification gives bonus points for starting position in race-heat 1 according to:

1st - 5 points; 2nd - 4 points; 3rd - 3 points; 4th - 2 points; 5th - 1 point.

The winner of the **F Nordic NEZ Cup 2019** is the driver awarded most points after the last heat. In the case of two or more drivers having the same number of points after the last heat, the result of the last heat decides the ranking for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place overall.

7. Entries

8. Free Practice, Qualifying and Race

According to each event/organizer's time schedule and with reference to § 7 (as below) in the Officiellt Formula Nordic Reglemente 2019.

§ 7 Grid

Grid race-heat no 1:

The fastest lap-time a competitor achieves in the timed qualification determines the starting grid in the first race-heat at the event.

Grid race-heat no 2 - events with 2 race-heats:

The fastest lap-time a competitor achieves in the timed qualification determines the starting grid in the second race-heat at the event. Position 1-6 starts in accordance with the final starting grid for the first race-heat, but in reverse starting order.

Grid race-heat no 2 - events with 3 race-heats:

The second (2nd) fastest lap-time a competitor achieves in the timed qualification determines the starting grid in the second race-heat at the event.

Grid race-heat no 3 - events with 3 race-heats:

The fastest lap-time a competitor achieves in the timed qualification determines the starting grid in the third race-heat at the event. Position 1-6 starts in accordance with the final starting grid for the first race-heat, but in reverse starting order.

9. Fuel

According to Formula Nordic Reglemente 2019, Official Formula Nordic Technical Regulations 2019 and Formula Nordic User Manual 2014 v1.1 & Nomenclature 2014 UK.

10. Tire and tire limitation

According to Formula Nordic Reglemente 2019, Official Formula Nordic Technical Regulations 2019 and Formula Nordic User Manual 2014 v1.1 & Nomenclature 2014 UK.

11. Time-keeping

All competitors must have their own or rented time-keeping transponder mounted and working when the car is on the track (free practice, qualifying and race).
